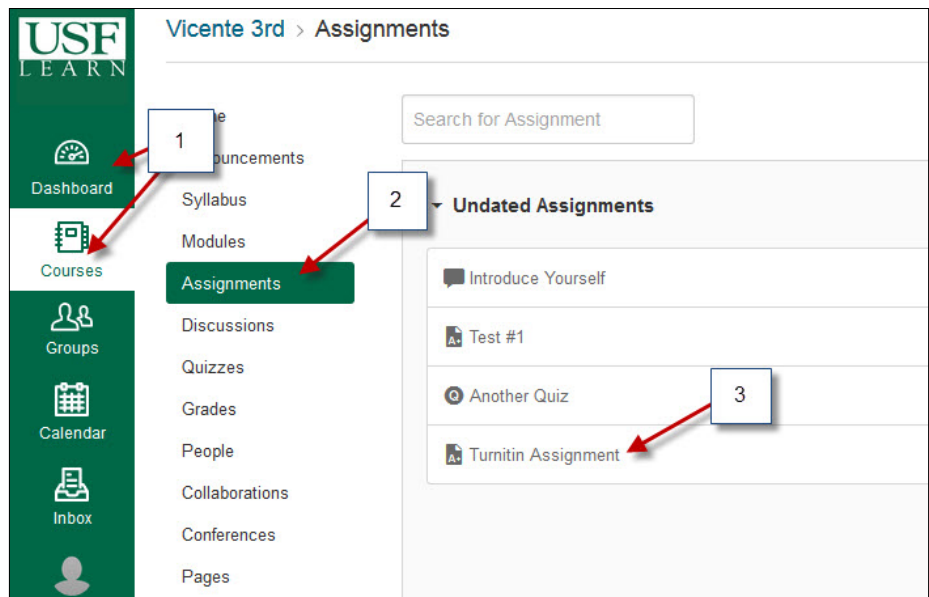


# SUBMITTING AND VIEWING MY TURNITIN REPORT

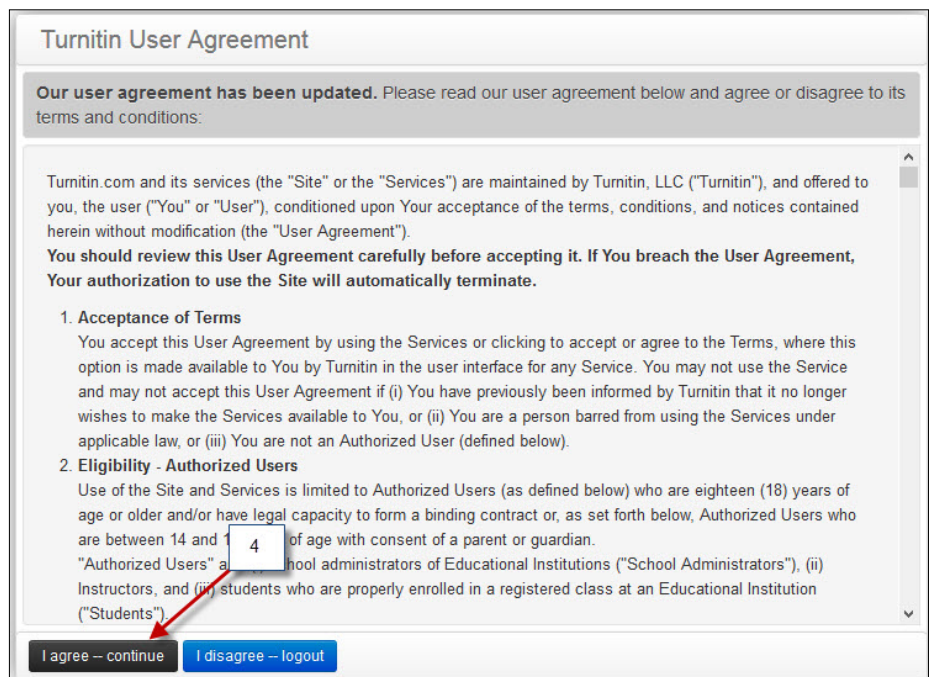
1) Go to your course using the **Dashboard or Courses** tab

3) Open the Assignment

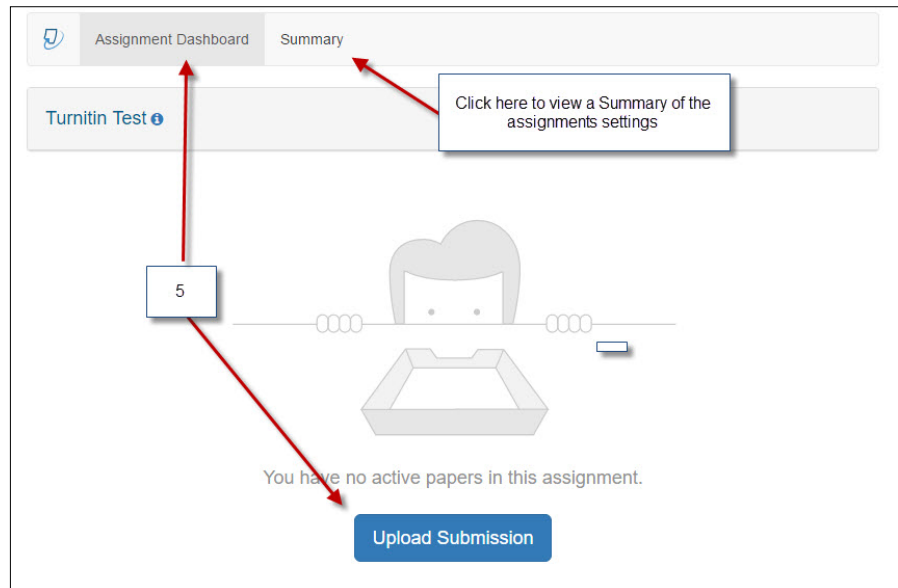


4) If you get this message Click **"I agree-continue"** with the Turnitin User Agreement



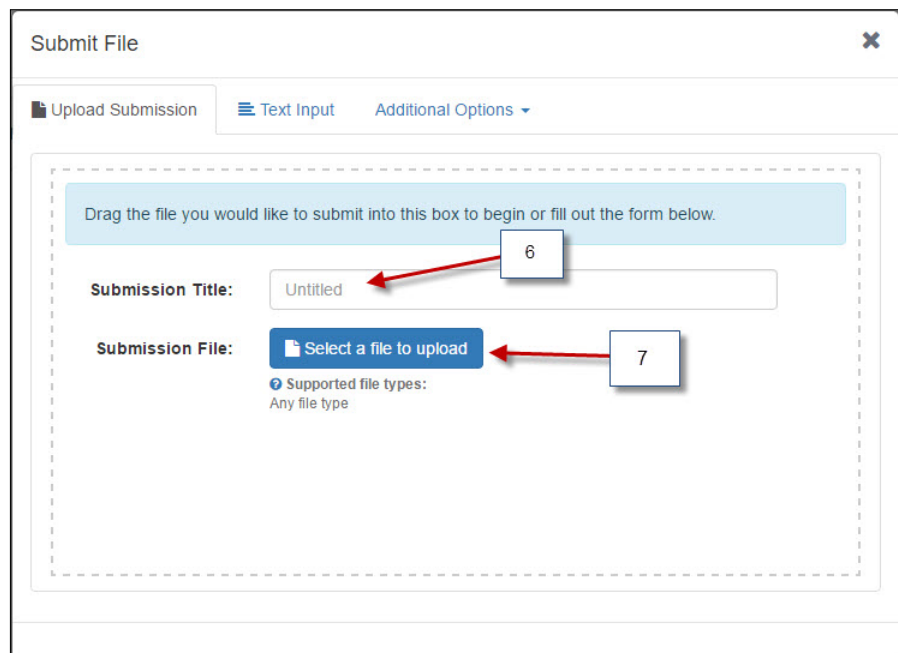
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5) Click Upload Submission


